

Design to Lead (DTL)

Design to Lead (DTL) is an extensive design thinking approach developed by Dr. Anurag Mairal, PhD, an Adjunct Professor. This exclusive workshop is customized for accepted LEAD students, teaching them how to employ the Bio Design model to address community issues. Please note that enrollment in this program is by invitation only, and registering for the LEAD program doesn't guarantee access to DTL until acceptance.

We've established acceptance criteria for DTL to ensure it's the right fit for both students and Program Leaders:

- 1. DTL participants must complete 25 hours of volunteering between October 1 and December 31, 2023.
- 2. Specific DTL selection criteria will be discussed during the info session.
- 3. Parent volunteering is mandatory, with each family providing a minimum of 20 hours of support during the year to ensure program success.
- 4. The workshop, requiring 2-3 hours per week from Jan '24 to Sep '24, enhances leadership and problem-solving skills, benefiting students across various domains.
