## A perfect start to 2024





Sewa DC chapter started 2024 with a fabulous gathering of attendees interested in learning about the LEAD program. We received a large number of applications for the DTL (Design to Lead) and the LEAD programs. After a rigorous selection process, 14 members were accepted into the DTL program while 50 were selected for the LEAD program.

The inaugural in-person orientation session for LEAD was held at the Silverline Center in McLean, Virginia, featuring Shri Suresh V. Shenoy, President of WHEELS Global Foundation and a prominent member of the community. He shared his inspiring journey from India to the United States while highlighting the importance of community service through "tan-man-dhan" - time, talent, and treasure. He also recounted experiences from his work with the Pan-IIT group, his philanthropic initiatives, and technology-driven projects for societal betterment.

The first month of the new year ended with several exciting activities including the recruitment for YFS (Youth for Sewa) board positions and Sewa internships. Currently, the interview process for these two important initiatives is underway. The interview panel led by parent volunteers along with Sewa leadership plans to notify the selected candidates by the second week of February.

The DC Chapter board met in late January and conducted annual planning for the current year. With many important initiatives and events in the pipeline, we anticipate a busy, productive, and engaging 2024.


